Pisces: the twelfth astrological sign in the zodiac and Latin for the word *fishes*. Goddess Aphrodite and son Eros were rescued by two fish who were later honored in the heavens as the constellation Pisces.

Because it is the last sign, Pisces carries with it the old soul of the zodiac. As a feminine water sign, it has traits of compassion, imagination, sensitivity and intuition, as well as idealism, un-confidence and escapism. It is, however, known as one of the most spiritual signs. With the [full moon](#) wide in this sign, dreams and magic hover in the air.

Ruled by Neptune, God of the Sea, Pisces is the ruler of the waters: oceans, rivers, lakes, rain, bodies. Water is one of the purest elements, picking up energy all around it. Our bodies, which are 90% water, are very attune with these energies and intuitive marks, yet many of us have somehow disconnected from this nature. Now may be the time to revisit this.

The full moon brings to the surface anything we have kept hidden in the crevices of our souls—shadows, ghosts and ghouls. The light of the full moon will light up the darkness and behold!—there in the crypts, love will flourish once again. 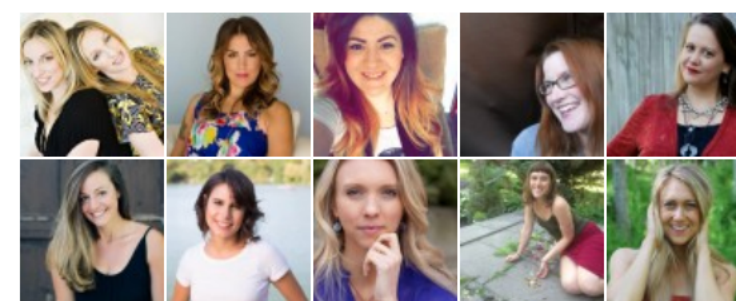
